

Claudia's Corner

I just made this for a recent potluck and it literally disappeared in about 5 minutes flat! So rich and yummy and super easy.



CHOCOLATE PEANUT TORTE

Crust: (or see below ***)

2 cups vanilla wafer crumbs

1/3 cup butter, melted

2/3 cup peanuts, finely chopped

Combine all of the above ingredients and press into an ungreased 9" x 13" baking dish.

Bake at 350 degrees for 8 – 10 minutes or until lightly browned. Cool

Filling:

1. In a mixing bowl, beat until smooth:

8 oz softened cream cheese

1 cup powdered sugar

1/2 cup peanut butter

Fold in 2 cups Cool Whip

Spread over crust.

2. In a mixing bowl, beat for 2 minutes:

3 cups cold milk

2 packages (3.9 oz each) instant chocolate pudding mix

Carefully spread over cream cheese layer.

Cover and refrigerate for 4 – 6 hours.

3. Just before serving carefully spread 2 cups Cool Whip over the pudding layer.

Sprinkle with grated chocolate and 1/3 cup finely chopped peanuts.

Yield: 16 – 20 servings

***Alternate crust as served at ladies dominoes:



1/2 cup chopped nuts


1 stick butter - softened

1 cup flour

Mix well. Pat into a 9" x 13" baking pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 15 minutes.

Cool and top with filling steps shown above.


